MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY TEMPORARY PERMITS

SFC 17.01 Temporary permits.

Note: Chapter SFC 17 was created as an emergency rule effective April 26, 1993.

SFC 17.01 Temporary permits. A temporary permit for the use of the title marriage and family therapist shall be issued to a person who has completed the educational and supervised practice requirements for eligibility for a certificate as a marriage and family therapist upon payment of the fee for the temporary permit and application for the next available examination. The temporary permit is valid for a period not to exceed 9 months from the date of its issuance, or the date on which examination scores are released, whichever occurs sooner. The marriage and fam-

ily therapists section may grant one renewal of the temporary permit in cases of hardship, for a period not to exceed 9 months or the date of the release of scores from the next available examination after the date of renewal of the temporary certificate, whichever occurs sooner. A person who fails the certification examination shall immediately return the temporary permit to the marriage and family therapists section. The marriage and family therapists section may not grant or renew a temporary permit to an applicant who has failed the certification examination.
