- (2) Determine the prior calendar year earnings of all active employes.
 - (3) Divide item (1) by item (2).

The amount credited to the reserve for annuities granted upon the granting of a disability annuity to a participating employe whose designated beneficiary would qualify to receive a death benefit under section 66.908 (2) (e), Wis. Stats., shall include a provision for such death benefit computed upon the basis of the 1951 group annuity mortality table (male) rated back 5 years in the case of the beneficiary and rated back an additional 1/10 year multiplied by the difference between the year the annuity begins and 1958, in the ages of both the employe and the beneficiary; with interest at 3½% per year.
