

Chapter PSC 21

**PICKUP AND DELIVERY SERVICE BY
CONTRACT CARRIERS**

PSC 21.01 Pickup authorized PSC 21.03 Filing required
PSC 21.02 Filing of contracts PSC 21.04 Jurisdiction retained

PSC 21.01 Pickup authorized. Contract motor carriers licensed to transport property generally within a municipality are authorized to pick up and deliver, under employment by common motor carriers as members of the public served by the contract motor carrier, property transported between fixed termini by such common motor carriers.

PSC 21.02 Filing of contracts. Common motor carriers should be required to file their contracts, if written, and full information including such facts as the commission may specify, in forms available upon request, as to any oral contracts, for the employment of contract motor carriers to perform pickup and delivery service in connection with freight transported or to be transported between fixed termini by said common carriers.

PSC 21.03 Filing required. All intrastate common motor carriers are required to file with this commission within 10 days from date hereof, the data hereinbefore specified as to all such existing contracts, and to file not less than 10 days preceding the performance of any such contract the data hereinbefore specified as to all such future contracts.

PSC 21.04 Jurisdiction retained. Jurisdiction in this matter shall be retained for such further proceedings as the commission may find necessary upon receipt of the contracts and information herein ordered to be filed.
