



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 43,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 130**

May 24, 1995 – Offered by Representatives ALBERS, LADWIG, LORGE and JOHNSRUD.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 400, line 20: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 9153. Nonstatutory provisions; supreme court.**

4 (1x) STUDY OF ELIMINATION OF JUVENILE JURY TRIALS. The director of state courts
5 shall prepare and submit to the appropriate standing committees under section
6 13.172 (3) of the statutes, the joint committee on finance and the governor a report
7 on the effects of the elimination of jury trials in cases under chapter 938 of the
8 statutes, as created by this act, on the administration of juvenile justice. The report
9 shall examine the effect of that jury trial elimination on the cost to counties in
10 administering juvenile justice and whether that elimination of jury trials gives
11 judges greater opportunities to devote time to determining the most appropriate
12 dispositions for juveniles.”.
