



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 9,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 130**

March 23, 1995 – Offered by Representative LADWIG.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1. Page 89, line 10:** delete “sub.” and substitute “sub.”; and delete the 2nd “or”
and substitute “(1g) or”.

3 **2. Page 89, line 16:** after that line insert:

4 “SECTION 312m. 48.396 (1g) of the statutes is created to read:

5 48.396 (1g) If requested by the parent, guardian or legal custodian of a child
6 who is the subject of a peace officer’s report, or if requested by the child, if 14 years
7 of age or over, a law enforcement agency may provide to the parent, guardian, legal
8 custodian or child a copy of that report.”.

9 **3. Page 89, line 24:** after that line insert:

10 “SECTION 314g. 48.396 (2) (ag) of the statutes is created to read:

11 48.396 (2) (ag) Upon request of the parent, guardian or legal custodian of a
12 child who is the subject of a record of a court specified in par. (a), or upon request of
13 the child, if 14 years of age or over, the court shall open for inspection by the parent,
14 guardian, legal custodian or child the records of the court relating to that child.”.

1 **4. Page 101, line 5:** after that line insert:

2 “**SECTION 368g.** 48.78 (2) (ag) of the statutes is created to read:

3 48.78 (2) (ag) Paragraph (a) does not prohibit an agency from making available
4 for inspection or disclosing the contents of a record, upon the request of the parent,
5 guardian or legal custodian of the child who is the subject of the record or upon the
6 request of the child, if 14 years of age or over, to the parent, guardian, legal custodian
7 or child.”.

8 **5. Page 342, line 11:** after “sub.” insert: “(1b),”.

9 **6. Page 342, line 20:** after that line insert:

10 “(1b) If requested by the parent, guardian or legal custodian of a juvenile who
11 is the subject of a peace officer’s report, or if requested by the juvenile, if 14 years of
12 age or over, a law enforcement agency may provide to the parent, guardian, legal
13 custodian or juvenile a copy of that report.”.

14 **7. Page 344, line 10:** after that line insert:

15 “(ag) Upon request of the parent, guardian or legal custodian of a juvenile who
16 is the subject of a record of a court specified in par. (a), or upon request of the juvenile,
17 if 14 years of age or over, the court shall open for inspection by the parent, guardian,
18 legal custodian or juvenile the records of the court relating to that juvenile.”.

19 **8. Page 378, line 7:** after that line insert:

20 “(ag) Paragraph (a) does not prohibit an agency from making available for
21 inspection or disclosing the contents of a record, upon the request of the parent,
22 guardian or legal custodian of the juvenile who is the subject of the record or upon

1 the request of the juvenile, if 14 years of age or over, to the parent, guardian, legal
2 custodian or juvenile.”
