



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 141**

April 28, 1995 – Offered by Representative URBAN.

1 **AN ACT to create** 175.36 of the statutes; **relating to:** the retail sale of firearms
2 and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 175.36 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **175.36 Trigger or cable lock required upon sale of firearm.** (1) In this
5 section, “firearms dealer” means any person engaged in the retail sale of firearms
6 and having a license as a dealer issued by the U.S. department of the treasury.

7 **(2)** (a) When a firearms dealer sells any firearm, he or she may not transfer
8 possession of that firearm to any other person unless the firearm is securely locked
9 with a trigger lock or cable lock, unless the firearm cannot, because of its design and
10 manufacture, be fitted with a trigger lock or cable lock.

11 (b) No person who is buying a firearm from a firearms dealer may take
12 possession of the firearm unless it is securely locked with a trigger lock or cable lock,
13 unless the firearm cannot, because of its design and manufacture, be fitted with a
14 trigger lock or cable lock.
