



**SENATE AMENDMENT 20,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 150**

June 27, 1995 – Offered by Senators RISSER, CHVALA, WINEKE and JAUCH.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the engrossed bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 5: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with

7 13.48 (10) APPROVAL BY BUILDING COMMISSION. No state board, agency, officer,  
8 department, commission or body corporate may enter into a contract for the  
9 construction, reconstruction, remodeling of or addition to any building, structure, or  
10 facility, which involves a cost in excess of \$100,000, without completion of final plans  
11 and arrangement for supervision of construction and prior approval by the building  
12 commission. The building commission may not approve a contract for the  
13 construction, reconstruction, renovation or remodeling of or an addition to a state  
14 building as defined in s. 44.51 (2) unless it determines that s. 16.846 or 44.57 has been

1 complied with or does not apply. This section applies to the department of  
2 transportation only in respect to buildings, structures and facilities to be used for  
3 administrative or operating functions, including buildings, land and equipment to  
4 be used for the motor vehicle emission inspection and maintenance program under  
5 s. 110.20. This subsection does not apply to contracts by the department of natural  
6 resources for construction work related to hazardous substance spill response under  
7 s. 144.76 or environmental repair under s. 144.442. This subsection does not apply  
8 to projects approved by the governor in response to emergency situations under s.  
9 16.855 (16) (b) or to allocations from the appropriation made under s. 20.867 (2) for  
10 special category projects when the building commission has released funds under  
11 sub. (3) and has also approved a plan for the expenditure of those funds. "Special  
12 category projects" for the purpose of this subsection include but are not limited to  
13 projects such as special maintenance, energy conservation, handicapped access and  
14 advance property acquisition designated by the building commission.

15 **SECTION 24c.** 13.48 (13) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

16 13.48 (13) (a) Except as provided in par. (b) or (c), every building, structure or  
17 facility that is constructed for the benefit of or use of the state or any state agency,  
18 board, commission or department shall be in compliance with all applicable state  
19 laws, rules, codes and regulations but the construction is not subject to the  
20 ordinances or regulations of the municipality in which the construction takes place  
21 except zoning, including without limitation because of enumeration ordinances or  
22 regulations relating to materials used, permits, supervision of construction or  
23 installation, payment of permit fees, or other restrictions."

9 (4m), 48.357 (4) and (5) (e), 48.366, 51.10, 51.13, 51.15, 51.20, 51.35 (3), 51.37 (5),  
10 51.45 (10), (11), (12) and (13), 55.05, 55.06, 971.14 (2) and (5), 971.17 (1), 975.06 and  
11 980.06, receiving care, maintenance, services and supplies provided by any  
12 institution in this state including ~~university of Wisconsin hospital and clinics~~  
13 University of Wisconsin Hospitals and Clinics, in which the state is chargeable with  
14 all or part of the person’s care, maintenance, services and supplies, any person  
15 receiving care and services from a county department established under s. 51.42 or  
16 51.437 or from a facility established under s. ~~49.175~~ 49.73, and any person receiving  
17 treatment and services from a public or private agency under s. 971.17 (3) (d) or (4)  
18 (e), 980.06 (2) (c) or 980.08 (5) and the person’s property and estate, including the  
19 homestead, and the spouse of the person, and the spouse’s property and estate,  
20 including the homestead, and, in the case of a minor child, the parents of the person,  
21 and their property and estates, including their homestead, and, in the case of a  
22 foreign child described in s. 48.839 (1) who became dependent on public funds for his

1 or her primary support before an order granting his or her adoption, the resident of  
2 this state appointed guardian of the child by a foreign court who brought the child  
3 into this state for the purpose of adoption, and his or her property and estate,  
4 including his or her homestead, shall be liable for the cost of the care, maintenance,  
5 services and supplies in accordance with the fee schedule established by the  
6 department under s. 46.03 (18). If a spouse, widow or minor, or an incapacitated  
7 person may be lawfully dependent upon the property for their support, the court  
8 shall release all or such part of the property and estate from the charges that may  
9 be necessary to provide for those persons. The department shall make every  
10 reasonable effort to notify the liable persons as soon as possible after the beginning  
11 of the maintenance, but the notice or the receipt thereof is not a condition of liability.”
