814.65 (1) Court costs. In a municipal court action, except an action for violation of an ordinance in conformity with s. 347.48 (2m), the municipal judge shall collect a fee of \$15 \$23 on each separate matter, whether it is on default of appearance, a plea of guilty or no contest, on issuance of a warrant or summons or the action is tried as a contested matter. Of each \$15 \$23 fee received by the judge under this subsection, the municipal treasurer shall pay monthly one—third \$5 to the state treasurer for deposit in the general fund and shall retain the balance for the use of the municipality.
