



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 260**

June 21, 1995 – Offered by Representative GROTHMAN.

1 **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 125.69 (6); *to amend* 125.69 (6) (title); and  
2 *to create* 125.69 (6) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** permitting “Class B”  
3 licensees to purchase intoxicating liquor from “Class A” licensees.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

4 **SECTION 1.** 125.69 (6) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 125.69 (6) (title) ~~CAMPUSES PURCHASES BY CAMPUSES AND RETAILERS TO PURCHASE~~  
6 ~~FROM PERSONS HOLDING PERMITS.~~

7 **SECTION 2.** 125.69 (6) of the statutes is renumbered 125.69 (6) (a) and amended  
8 to read:

9 125.69 (6) (a) ~~No~~ Except as provided in par. (b), no campus or retail licensee or  
10 permittee may purchase or possess intoxicating liquor purchased from any person  
11 other than a manufacturer, rectifier or wholesaler holding a permit under this  
12 chapter for the sale of intoxicating liquor.

13 (c) Any person who violates this subsection may be fined not more than \$10,000  
14 or imprisoned for not more than 9 months or both.
