



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 401**

March 5, 1996 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY.

1 **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 893.29 (2); *to amend* 893.29 (1); and *to create*
2 893.29 (2m) and 893.29 (4) of the statutes; **relating to:** obtaining title to public
3 real property by adverse possession, prescription or user.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 893.29 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 893.29 (1) Title Except as provided in subs. (2m) and (3), title to or interest in
6 real property belonging to the state or a city, village, town, county, school district,
7 sewerage commission, sewerage district or any other unit of government within this
8 state may be obtained by adverse possession, prescription or user under s. 893.25,
9 893.26, 893.27 or 893.28 only if the adverse possession, prescription or user
10 continues uninterruptedly for more than 20 years.

11 **SECTION 2.** 893.29 (2) of the statutes is renumbered 893.29 (3), and 893.29 (3)
12 (intro.), as renumbered, is amended to read:
