



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 557**

October 3, 1995 – Offered by Representatives LORGE and SCHNEIDER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 19: after the semicolon insert “use of social security numbers;”.

3 **2.** Page 57, line 5: after that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 143m.** 343.022 of the statutes is created to read:

5 **343.022 Requesting social security numbers.** Except as provided in s.
6 343.14 (2) (b), the department may not require an individual, for the purposes of chs.
7 340 to 349 and 351, to disclose his or her social security number, but may request an
8 individual to disclose his or her social security number to assist the department in
9 accessing his or her records if the department informs the individual that he or she
10 may refuse to disclose the number.”.
