ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 9, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 3, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 591

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 58, line 6: after that line insert:
3	"(2t) CHILD WELFARE SERVICES. (a) <i>Reports</i> . The department shall maintain a
4	record for each county detailing the number of children of each participant and
5	former participant who first receive child welfare services after the participant or
6	former participant began participating in Wisconsin works and the amount
7	expended by each county on child welfare services for those children. The
8	department shall coordinate with the department of health and family services in
9	obtaining any information necessary for compiling the record.
10	(b) Reimbursement to counties. From the appropriation under s. 20.445 (3) (dz),
11	the department shall reimburse counties for 100% of the costs associated with
12	providing child welfare services to the children detailed in the report under par. (a).".
