



**SENATE AMENDMENT 11,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 591**

March 13, 1996 – Offered by Senator DECKER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute  
2 amendment 3, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 79, line 24: delete the material beginning with that line and ending  
4 with page 80, line 4, and substitute:

5 “(a) *Trial jobs.* For a participant in a trial job, the amount established in the  
6 contract between the Wisconsin works agency and the trial job employer, but not less  
7 than the following:

8 1. In a county having a population of 70,000 or more, \$7 for every hour actually  
9 worked in the trial job, not to exceed 40 hours per week, paid by the employer. Hours  
10 spent participating in education and training activities under s. 49.147 (3) (am) shall  
11 be included in determining the number of hours actually worked.

12 2. In a county having a population under 70,000, \$6 for every hour actually  
13 worked in the trial job, not to exceed 40 hours per week, paid by the employer. Hours  
14 spent participating in education and training activities under s. 49.147 (3) (am) shall  
15 be included in determining the number of hours actually worked.”.
