1	AN ACT to repeal 20.235 (1) (gm); and to repeal and recreate 39.38 (2) of the
2	statutes; relating to: Indian student assistance grants.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **SECTION 1.** 20.235 (1) (gm) of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27, is repealed.
 - **Section 2.** 39.38 (2) of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27, section 1887g, is repealed and recreated to read:
 - 39.38 (2) Grants under this section shall be based on financial need, as determined by the department. The maximum grant shall not exceed \$2,200 per year. Grants shall be awarded to students for full-time or part-time attendance at any accredited institution of higher education in this state. The department may not make a grant under this section to a student if the department receives a certification under s. 46.255 (7) that the student is delinquent in child support or maintenance payments. Grants shall be renewable for up to 5 years if a recipient remains in good academic standing at the institution that he or she is attending. The American
