



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 801**

March 22, 1996 - Offered by JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.

1 **AN ACT to repeal** 20.235 (1) (gm); and **to repeal and recreate** 39.38 (2) of the  
2 statutes; **relating to:** Indian student assistance grants.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3 **SECTION 1.** 20.235 (1) (gm) of the statutes, as created by 1995 Wisconsin Act  
4 27, is repealed.

5 **SECTION 2.** 39.38 (2) of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27,  
6 section 1887g, is repealed and recreated to read:

7 39.38 (2) Grants under this section shall be based on financial need, as  
8 determined by the department. The maximum grant shall not exceed \$2,200 per  
9 year. Grants shall be awarded to students for full-time or part-time attendance at  
10 any accredited institution of higher education in this state. The department may not  
11 make a grant under this section to a student if the department receives a certification  
12 under s. 46.255 (7) that the student is delinquent in child support or maintenance  
13 payments. Grants shall be renewable for up to 5 years if a recipient remains in good  
14 academic standing at the institution that he or she is attending. The American

1 Indian language and culture education board shall advise the department on the  
2 allocation of grants to students enrolled less than half time.

3 **SECTION 3. Effective date.**

4 (1) INDIAN STUDENT ASSISTANCE GRANTS. This act takes effect on July 1, 1996, or  
5 on the day after publication, whichever is later.
