



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 83**

November 1, 1995 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after “worker” insert “, emergency medical technician, first
3 responder or ambulance driver”.

4 **2.** Page 1, line 4: after that line insert:

5 “1e. “Ambulance” has the meaning given in s. 146.50 (1) (a).”.

6 **3.** Page 1, line 5: substitute “1g.” for “1.”.

7 **4.** Page 2, line 3: after that line insert:

8 “2g. “Emergency medical technician” has the meaning given in s. 146.50 (1) (e).

9 2m. “First responder” has the meaning given in s. 146.53 (1) (d).”.

10 **5.** Page 2, line 7: delete lines 7 to 9, as affected by assembly amendment 1, and
11 substitute:

12 “(b) Whoever intentionally causes bodily harm to an emergency department
13 worker, an emergency medical technician, a first responder or an ambulance driver
14 who is acting in an official capacity and who the person knows or has reason to know

1 is an emergency department worker, an emergency medical technician, a first
2 responder or an ambulance driver, by an act done without the consent of the person”.
