



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 SENATE BILL 600**

March 27, 1996 – Offered by Senators SHIBILSKI, DRZEWIECKI, WELCH and ZIEN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: before the period insert: “and designating STH 66 as the
3 “Polish Heritage Memorial Highway””.

4 **2.** Page 2, line 9: after that line insert:

5 “SECTION 2m. 84.1048 of the statutes is created to read:

6 **84.1048 Polish Heritage Memorial Highway. (1)** In recognition of the
7 outstanding contributions that Polish Americans have made to the vitality and
8 quality of life in central Wisconsin, the department shall designate STH 66,
9 commencing at Polonia and proceeding easterly to Rosholt, as the “Polish Heritage
10 Memorial Highway” to commemorate and honor the achievements of central
11 Wisconsin residents of Polish ancestry.

12 **(2)** Upon receipt of contributions totaling not less than \$800 from interested
13 parties, including any city, village, town or county, the department shall erect
14 markers along STH 66 in the following locations:

15 (a) One marker at the west end of Polonia to clearly identify the designation
16 of the route to motorists proceeding easterly.
