



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 180**

May 8, 1997 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 347.25 (2) of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring strobe lights
2 on school buses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 347.25 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 347.25 (2) No person may operate a school bus which is painted as provided in
5 s. 347.44 unless it is equipped with flashing red signals. ~~In addition to the flashing~~
6 ~~red signals, the school bus may be equipped and~~ with a 360-degree flashing white
7 strobe light with having a flashrate of 60 to 120 per minute. The secretary shall
8 prescribe rules for the type, installation, operation and light output brilliance of the
9 signals and lights required ~~or permitted~~ under this subsection. No vehicle may be
10 equipped with such flashing red signals ~~or flashing red signals~~ and a strobe light
11 unless it also is painted as provided in s. 347.44.
