



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 280**

May 13, 1997 - Offered by Representative WASSERMAN.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 252.15 (7) (c) (intro.); and **to create** 252.15 (7m) of the statutes;  
2 **relating to:** disclosure to the state epidemiologist of the names of persons  
3 significantly exposed to the human immunodeficiency virus.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

4 **SECTION 1.** 252.15 (7) (c) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:  
5 252.15 (7) (c) (intro.) ~~A~~ Except as provided in sub. (7m), a report made under  
6 par. (b) may not include any of the following:

7 **SECTION 2.** 252.15 (7m) of the statutes is created to read:  
8 252.15 (7m) REPORTING OF PERSONS SIGNIFICANTLY EXPOSED. If a positive,  
9 validated test result is obtained from a test subject, the test subject's physician who  
10 maintains a record of the test result under sub. (4) (c) may report to the state  
11 epidemiologist the name of any person known to the physician to have been

1 significantly exposed to the test subject, only after the physician has done all of the  
2 following:

3 (a) Counseled the test subject to inform any person who has been significantly  
4 exposed to the test subject.

5 (b) Notified the test subject that the name of any person known to the physician  
6 to have been significantly exposed to the test subject will be reported to the state  
7 epidemiologist.
