**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO SENATE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 736**

April 28, 1998 – Offered by Representative SCHNEIDER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 5: after that line insert:

3 “4m. Page 8, line 3: before that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 13g.** 29.09 (11m) (a) (intro.) and (d) 2. of the statutes, as created by  
5 1997 Wisconsin Act .... (Senate Bill 494), are amended to read:

6 **29.09 (11m)** DENIAL AND REVOCATION OF APPROVALS BASED ON CHILD SUPPORT  
7 DELINQUENCY. (a) *Social security numbers required.* (intro.) The Except as provided  
8 in par. (e), the department shall require an applicant who is an individual to provide  
9 his or her social security number as a condition of applying for, or applying to renew,  
10 any of the following approvals:

11 (d) 2. As provided in the memorandum of understanding required under s.  
12 49.857 (2) and except as provided in par. (e), the department shall deny an

1 application to issue or renew an approval specified in par. (a) 1. to 3. if the applicant  
2 for or the holder of the approval fails to provide his or her social security number as  
3 required under par. (a).

4 **SECTION 13m.** 29.09 (11m) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

5 29.09 (11m) (e) *Refusal for religious reasons.* The department may not require  
6 an applicant for an approval specified in par. (a) 1. to 3. to provide his or her social  
7 security number if the applicant refuses to provide his or her social security number  
8 for religious reasons. The department may not deny an application to issue or renew  
9 an approval on the basis of par. (a) if the applicant for or holder of the approval  
10 refuses to provide his or her social security number for religious reasons.”.”.
