**SENATE AMENDMENT 6,
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 768**

May 7, 1998 – Offered by Senators JAUCH, DECKER, SHIBILSKI, WIRCH, GROBSCHMIDT,
CLAUSING, C. POTTER, MOORE, RISSER, PLACHE, CHVALA, MOEN and BURKE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute
2 amendment 1, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 12, line 18: after “school aid;” insert “the number of schools eligible for
4 achievement guarantee contracts;”.

5 **2.** Page 292, line 19: after that line insert:

6 “**SECTION 368cd.** 118.43 (2) (b) (intro.) of the statutes, as affected by 1997
7 Wisconsin Act 27, is amended to read:

8 118.43 (2) (b) (intro.) In the 1996–97 and 1998–99 school years, the school board
9 of an eligible school district may enter into a 5–year achievement guarantee contract
10 with the department on behalf of one school or more schools in the school district if
11 all of the following apply:

12 **SECTION 368cg.** 118.43 (2) (c) of the statutes is repealed.

13 **SECTION 368cL.** 118.43 (2) (d) of the statutes is repealed.
