**SENATE AMENDMENT 14,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1997 SENATE BILL 7**

November 4, 1997 – Offered by Senator ADELMAN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 3: delete “elimination of legislative partisan caucus staffs.”

3 **2.** Page 4, line 10: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
4 page 5, line 2, and substitute:

5 “7.08 (2) (c) As soon as possible after the canvass of the spring and September
6 primary votes, but no later than the first Tuesday in March and the 4th Tuesday in
7 September, transmit to the state treasurer a certified list of all eligible candidates
8 for state office who have filed applications under s. 11.50 (2) and ~~whom~~ who the board
9 determines to be eligible to receive payments from the Wisconsin election campaign
10 fund. The board shall also transmit a similar list of candidates who the board
11 determines to be eligible to receive a supplementary grant under s. 11.50 (3) (c), (4)
12 (e) or (9) (b) within 5 days after the candidates qualify to receive the grants. Each

1 list shall contain each candidate’s name, the mailing address indicated upon the
2 candidate’s registration form, the office for which the individual is a candidate and,
3 the party or principle which he or she represents, if any.”.

4 **3.** Page 5, line 14: delete lines 14 to 21 and substitute “candidate and the party
5 or principle which he or she represents, if any.”.

6 **4.** Page 6, line 9: substitute “3%” for “2%”.

7 **5.** Page 7, line 11: substitute “3%” for “2%”.

8 **6.** Page 22, line 11: delete “No” and substitute “Except as authorized in this
9 subsection, no”.

10 **7.** Page 22, line 14: after “official” insert “if the contribution is received by the
11 official or committee”.

12 **8.** Page 22, line 16: delete “and thereafter” and substitute “or thereafter”.

13 **9.** Page 22, line 22: after that line insert:

14 “(c) This subsection does not apply to a contribution made to an individual who
15 is a candidate for state office at a special election or a personal campaign committee
16 of such a candidate if the contribution is received by the candidate or committee
17 during the period commencing on the date that the special election is ordered and
18 ending on the date of the special election or the date of the special primary if the
19 candidate is not nominated at the primary.”.

20 **10.** Page 23, line 3: after that line insert:

21 “**SECTION 46m.** 11.26 (1) (a), (b) and (c) of the statutes are amended to read:

22 11.26 (1) (a) Candidates for governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state,
23 state treasurer, attorney general, state superintendent or justice, ~~\$10,000~~ \$1,000.

1 (b) Candidates for state senator, ~~\$1,000~~ \$500.

2 (c) Candidates for representative to the assembly, ~~\$500~~ \$250.”

3 **11.** Page 23, line 11: after that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 47m.** 11.26 (2) (a), (b) and (c) of the statutes are amended to read:

5 11.26 (2) (a) Candidates for governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state,
6 state treasurer, attorney general, state superintendent or justice, ~~4% of the value of~~
7 ~~the disbursement level specified in the schedule under s. 11.31 (1) \$1,000.~~

8 (b) Candidates for state senator, ~~\$1,000~~ \$500.

9 (c) Candidates for representative to the assembly, ~~\$500~~ \$250.”

10 **12.** Page 23, line 20: after “**(8m)**” insert “(a)”.

11 **13.** Page 23, line 20: delete “other committee” and substitute “other
12 committee.”.

13 **14.** Page 23, line 21: delete that line.

14 **15.** Page 23, line 22: before that line insert:

15 “(b) Paragraph (a) does not apply to a contribution made to a personal campaign
16 or support committee.”.

17 **16.** Page 30, line 22: substitute “3%” for “2%”.

18 **17.** Page 31, line 7: substitute “3%” for “2%”.

19 **18.** Page 31, line 10: substitute “3%” for “2%”.

20 **19.** Page 31, line 20: substitute “3%” for “2%”.

21 **20.** Page 32, line 7: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
22 with page 33, line 9, and substitute:

1 “11.50 (2) (b) 5. The financial reports filed by or on behalf of the candidate as
2 of the date of the spring or September primary, or the date that the special primary
3 is or would be held, if required, indicate that the candidate has received an amount
4 equal to at least the amount provided in this subdivision 5% of the applicable
5 authorized disbursement limitation for candidates other than candidates
6 challenging incumbent officeholders, as determined under s. 11.31 (1) and adjusted
7 under s. 11.31 (9), from contributions of money, other than loans, made by individuals
8 who reside in this state and in the case of a candidate for legislative office, made by
9 individuals at least 50% of whom reside in the legislative district in which the
10 candidate seeks office, which have been received during the period ending on the date
11 of the spring primary and July 1 preceding such date in the case of candidates at the
12 spring election, or the date of the September primary and January 1 preceding such
13 date in the case of candidates at the general election, or the date that a special
14 primary will or would be held, if required, and 90 days preceding such date or the
15 date a special election is ordered, whichever is earlier, in the case of special election
16 candidates, which contributions are in the aggregate amount of \$100 or less, and
17 which are fully identified and itemized as to the exact source thereof. A contribution
18 received from a conduit which is identified by the conduit as originating from an
19 individual shall may not be considered as a contribution made by the an individual
20 for the purpose of qualifying for a grant under this subdivision. Only the first \$100
21 of an aggregate contribution of more than \$100 may be counted toward the required
22 percentage. For a candidate at the spring or general election for an office identified
23 in s. 11.26 (1) (a) or a candidate at a special election, the required amount to qualify
24 for a grant is 5% of the candidate’s authorized disbursement limitation under s.
25 11.31. For any other candidate at the general election, the required amount to

1 ~~qualify for a grant is 10% of the candidate's authorized disbursement limitation~~
2 ~~under s. 11.31."~~

3 **21.** Page 33, line 10: delete lines 10 to 25.

4 **22.** Page 34, line 1: delete lines 1 to 23.

5 **23.** Page 35, line 5: substitute "3%" for "2%".

6 **24.** Page 38, line 5: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
7 with page 39, line 2, and substitute:

8 "11.50 (4) (c) The legislative and special election campaign account shall be
9 divided into a senate campaign account to receive 25% of the moneys, and an
10 assembly campaign account to receive 75% of the moneys. Each account shall then
11 be apportioned between all eligible candidates for the same office in the entire state.
12 No apportionment shall be made by legislative district, except as provided in par. (e).

13 (cm) ~~Each~~ Except as provided in par. (e) and sub. (9) (b), each eligible candidate
14 for the same office at a special election shall receive an equal amount, which amount
15 shall be equivalent to the maximum grant which was payable to any candidate for
16 that office at the most recent spring or general election. The amount shall be drawn
17 from the senate campaign account and the assembly campaign account in the same
18 proportions as the balance in each account bears to the total balance in both accounts
19 at the time that payments are made. Whenever there are insufficient moneys in the
20 senate campaign account and the assembly campaign account to make the payments
21 required by this paragraph, payments shall be appropriately reduced or
22 discontinued by the board.

23 (d) ~~Within~~ Except as provided in par. (e) and sub. (9) (b), within the accounts
24 established under this subsection for each office at each general election, the entire

1 amount of all available moneys shall be apportioned equally to all eligible
2 candidates.”.
