



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 14,
TO 2001 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 3**

January 30, 2001 – Offered by Representative CARPENTER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the resolution as follows:

2 **1.** Page 36, line 15: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 50m.** Assembly rule 48 (3) is created to read:

4 Assembly Rule 48 (3) All questions of passage, concurrence, and adoption of a
5 proposal that imposes a state mandate on a local unit of government are decided by
6 a two-thirds majority vote of a quorum.”.

7 **2.** Page 43, line 1: delete lines 1 to 2 and substitute:

8 “(7) Appeals are debatable and shall be, except for appeals relating to passage,
9 concurrence, or adoption, are decided by a majority of the members present and
10 voting on a roll call vote. Appeals relating to passage, concurrence, or adoption are
11 decided by a two-thirds majority of the members present and voting on a roll call
12 vote. The presiding officer may vote on appeals.”.

13 **3.** Page 51, line 22: after that line insert:
