TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 571, line 2: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 1556d.** 46.40 (9) (a) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 46.40 (9) (a) *Transfer to family care program and adult protective services*
5 *allocation.* (intro.) If a care management organization under s. 46.285 is available
6 in a county, the department may dispose of ~~the amount allocated under sub. (8) to~~
7 ~~that county and~~ not more than 21.3% of the amount allocated under sub. (2) to that
8 county as follows:”.

9 **2.** Page 574, line 18: after that line insert:

10 “**SECTION 1568mg.** 46.87 (5) (a) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

11 46.87 (5) (a) 3. The household meets financial eligibility requirements specified
12 by the department by rule, regardless of whether or not persons in the household are

1 eligible for the family care benefit under s. 46.286 in a county in which a care
2 management organization under s. 46.284 operates.

3 **SECTION 1568mh.** 46.87 (5) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 46.87 (5) (b) Provide or contract for the provision of services and goods or make
5 payments for services to ~~persons~~ a person with Alzheimer's disease living in a
6 residential ~~facilities~~ facility in the county who ~~meet~~ meets financial eligibility
7 requirements specified by the department by rule, regardless of whether the person
8 is eligible for the family care benefit under s. 46.286 in a county in which a care
9 management organization under s. 46.284 operates."
