



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 406**

January 13, 2004 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES.

1 **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 39.48; *to amend* 36.11 (47) (intro.) and 38.12
2 (13) (intro.); and *to create* 39.48 (1) of the statutes; **relating to:** college
3 reenrollment of persons called into active military service.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 36.11 (47) (intro.) of the statutes, as affected by 2003 Wisconsin Act
5 69, is amended to read:

6 36.11 (47) ARMED FORCES. (intro.) If a student who is ~~a resident of Wisconsin~~
7 and a member of a national guard or a member of a reserve unit of the U.S. armed
8 forces withdraws from school after September 11, 2001, because he or she is called
9 into state active duty ~~under ch. 21~~ or into active service with the U.S. armed forces
10 for at least 30 days, the board shall reenroll the student beginning in the semester
11 following his or her discharge from active duty or the next succeeding semester.

3 **SECTION 2.** 38.12 (13) (intro.) of the statutes, as affected by 2003 Wisconsin Act
4 69, is amended to read:

5 38.12 **(13) ARMED FORCES.** (intro.) If a student who is ~~a resident of Wisconsin~~
6 ~~and~~ a member of a national guard or a member of a reserve unit of the U.S. armed
7 forces withdraws from school after September 11, 2001, because he or she is called
8 into state active duty ~~under ch. 21~~ or into active service with the U.S. armed forces
9 for at least 30 days, the district board shall reenroll the student beginning in the
10 semester following his or her discharge from active duty or the next succeeding
11 semester, whichever the student prefers, and, at the student's request, do one of the
12 following for all courses from which the student had to withdraw:

13 **SECTION 3.** 39.48 of the statutes, as affected by 2003 Wisconsin Act 69, is
14 renumbered 39.48 (intro.) and amended to read:

15 **39.48 Armed forces.** (intro.) If a student who is ~~a resident of Wisconsin and~~
16 a member of a national guard or a member of a reserve unit of the U.S. armed forces
17 withdraws from a private nonprofit college or university located in this state after
18 September 11, 2001, because he or she is called into state active duty ~~under ch. 21~~
19 or into active service with the U.S. armed forces for at least 30 days, the college or
20 university shall, at the student's request, ~~grant~~ do all of the following:

21 (2) Grant the student an incomplete in all of the courses from which the student
22 had to withdraw and permit the student to complete the courses, within 6 months
23 after leaving state service or active service, without paying additional tuition or fees.
