



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 510**

November 18, 2003 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON URBAN AND LOCAL AFFAIRS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 23, line 16: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
3 with page 24, line 7, and substitute:

4 **"SECTION 43a.** 43.01 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 43.01 (3) "Municipality" means a city, district under s. 229.86 (3), village, town,
6 tribal government or tribal association, or a school district that maintained and
7 operated a public library facility prior to December 17, 1971.

8 **SECTION 46m.** 43.54 (1r) of the statutes is created to read:

9 43.54 (1r) (a) Boards appointed for a library operated by a district under s.
10 229.86 (3) shall consist of 7 to 11 members, as determined by the agreement under
11 s. 229.861 (3) who shall be appointed by the commission under s. 229.86 (2).

12 (b) Subsections (1) (b) to (e) and (2) apply to boards under this subsection.

13 **SECTION 46r.** 43.64 (2) (c) of the statutes is created to read:
