**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 658**

January 22, 2004 – Offered by Representative MUSSER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 5, line 14: delete “hires” and substitute “appoints”.

3 **2.** Page 5, line 15: after “deputies” insert “under sub. (2)”.

4 **3.** Page 6, line 3: after that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 7m.** 61.65 (1) (a) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 61.65 (1) (a) (intro.) Except as provided under s. 61.66, each village with a  
7 population of 5,000 or more shall, and each village with a population of under 5,000  
8 may, provide police protection services by one of the following methods:”.

9 **4.** Page 6, line 7: delete lines 7 to 10 and substitute “services in all parts of the  
10 village. If the village is located in more than one county, it may not abolish its police  
11 department under this subdivision unless the village enters into a contract under  
12 this subdivision with the county in which the greatest amount of the village’s

1 equalized value, population, or territory is located. If a village wishes to abolish its  
2 police”.

3 **5.** Page 7, line 15: delete lines 15 to 18 and substitute “enforcement services  
4 in all parts of the city. If the city is located in more than one county, it may not abolish  
5 its police department under this subsection unless the city enters into a contract  
6 under this subsection with the county in which the greatest amount of the city’s  
7 equalized value, population or territory is located.”.
