



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 766**

February 19, 2004 – Offered by Representative KREIBICH.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 1: delete lines 1 to 7 and substitute:

3 “**SECTION 1g.** 175.40 (1) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

4 175.40 (1) (d) “University police” means the University of Wisconsin System
5 police under s. 36.11 (2).

6 **SECTION 1m.** 175.40 (5) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 175.40 (5) (a) 1. and
7 amended to read:

8 175.40 (5) (a) 1. ~~For~~ Subject to subd. 2., for any county having a population of
9 500,000 or more, if any law enforcement officer has territorial jurisdiction that is
10 wholly or partially within that county and has authority to arrest a person within
11 the officer’s territorial jurisdiction, the officer may arrest that person anywhere in
12 the county.

13 **SECTION 1r.** 175.40 (5) (a) 2. of the statutes is created to read:
