



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2003 SENATE BILL 277**

February 13, 2004 – Offered by Senator HARSDORF.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 5, line 19: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 11m.** 23.33 (5) (b) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

4 23.33 (5) (b) *All-terrain vehicle safety certificate.* 1. No person who is at least
5 12 years of age and who is born on or after January 1, 1988, may operate an
6 all-terrain vehicle unless he or she holds a valid safety certificate.

7 2. Any person who is required to hold an all-terrain vehicle safety certificate
8 while operating an all-terrain vehicle shall carry the certificate on the all-terrain
9 vehicle and shall display the certificate to a law enforcement officer on request.
10 Persons enrolled in a safety certification program approved by the department may
11 operate an all-terrain vehicle in an area designated by the instructor.”.
