**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 1188**

April 25, 2006 – Offered by Representative SCHNEIDER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after “absence” insert “and provision of benefits to legislators  
3 and other state elected officials who become candidates for state elected offices”.

4 **2.** Page 1, line 3: before that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 1e.** 20.923 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

6 20.923 (2m) SUSPENSION OF BENEFITS. Notwithstanding ss. 13.123 (1), 13.45 (3)  
7 (a), 40.02 (17), and 40.05 (4) (a) 3., if a legislator or other state elected official becomes  
8 a candidate for any state elected office that he or she does not currently hold, the  
9 legislator or other state elected official may not receive during the period of his or her  
10 candidacy any of the following:

11 (a) Health insurance coverage under subch. IV of ch. 40.

12 (b) Creditable service under the Wisconsin Retirement System.

13 (c) Payment of any allowance for, or reimbursement of, legislative expenses.

1 (d) Use of any staff assigned to his or her office.”.

2 **3.** Page 1, line 3: delete “**SECTION 1**” and substitute “**SECTION 1m**”.
