



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 207**

June 2, 2005 - Offered by Representative HUNDERTMARK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 5, line 19: after that line insert:

3 **"SECTION 4m.** 111.337 (2) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

4 111.337 (2) (c) To engage in any action prohibited under s. 111.322 on the basis
5 of an employee's or prospective employee's violation of, or statement of intent to
6 violate, s. 146.83 (4) (b)."

7 **2.** Page 6, line 2: substitute "the hospital" for "the hospital".

8 **3.** Page 10, line 5: after that line insert:

9 **"SECTION 14m.** 253.09 (6) of the statutes is created to read:

10 253.09 (6) (a) Nothing in this section prohibits any of the following:

11 1. Disciplinary or recriminatory action against a physician or any other person
12 who is a member of or associated with the staff of a health care facility, or any

1 employee of a health care facility who violates, or states an intention to violate, s.
2 146.83 (4) (b).

3 2. By a health care facility, school, or employer, discrimination with regard to
4 admission; hiring or firing; tenure, term, condition, or privilege of employment;
5 student status; or staff status against a person who violates, or states an intention
6 to violate, s. 146.83 (4) (b).

7 3. By a court, public official, or other public authority, an order requiring a
8 recipient, under state or federal law, of a grant, contract, loan, or loan guarantee to
9 comply with s. 146.83 (4) (b).

10 (b) Nothing in this section authorizes a health care facility, a physician, or any
11 other person who is a member of or associated with the staff of a health care facility,
12 or any employee of a health care facility to conceal or withhold a patient health care
13 record in violation of s. 146.83 (4) (b).

14 (c) Nothing in this section limits the liability of a health care facility, a
15 physician, or any other person who is a member of or associated with the staff of a
16 health care facility, or any employee of a health care facility for damage caused by
17 a violation of s. 146.83 (4) (b).”.

18 **4.** Page 12, line 5: after that line insert:

19 “**SECTION 19m.** 441.06 (7m) of the statutes is created to read:

20 441.06 (7m) (a) Nothing in sub. (6) (b) limits the liability of a person licensed
21 as a registered nurse under this section or as a practical nurse under s. 441.10 for
22 damage caused by a violation of s. 146.83 (4) (b).

23 (b) Nothing in sub. (7) authorizes a person licensed as a registered nurse under
24 this section or as a practical nurse under s. 441.10 to withhold or conceal a patient

1 health care record in violation of s. 146.83 (4) (b) or prohibits the board or department
2 from disciplining a person who violates s. 146.83 (4) (b).”.

3 **5.** Page 14, line 20: after that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 25m.** 448.03 (5) (ap) of the statutes is created to read:

5 448.03 (5) (ap) Nothing in par. (am) limits the liability of a person licensed or
6 certified under this subchapter for damage caused by a violation of s. 146.83 (4) (b).
7 Nothing in par. (an) authorizes a person licensed or certified under this subchapter
8 to withhold or conceal a patient health care record in violation of s. 146.83 (4) (b), or
9 prohibits the board or department from disciplining a person licensed or certified
10 under this subchapter who violates s. 146.83 (4) (b).”.

11 **6.** Page 16, line 19: delete “(a)”.

12 **7.** Page 17, line 1: before that line insert:

13 “**(3m)** (a) Nothing in sub. (2) limits the liability of a person licensed as a
14 pharmacist under this chapter for damage caused by a violation of s. 146.83 (4) (b).

15 (b) Nothing in sub. (3) authorizes a person licensed as a pharmacist under this
16 chapter to withhold or conceal a patient health care record in violation of s. 146.83
17 (4) (b) or prohibits the board or department from disciplining a person who violates
18 s. 146.83 (4) (b).”.

19 **8.** Page 17, line 1: substitute “**(4)** (a)” for “(b) 1.”.

20 **9.** Page 17, line 3: substitute “(b)” for “2.”.

21 **10.** Page 17, line 4: delete “par. (a)” and substitute “sub. (3)”.
