**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 990**

February 23, 2006 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 973.047 (1f) of the statutes; **relating to:** deoxyribonucleic acid  
2           testing of criminals.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3           **SECTION 1.** 973.046 (1r) of the statutes is amended to read:

4           973.046 (1r) If a court imposes a sentence or places a person on probation for  
5           a violation of s. 940.225, 944.20, 948.02 (1) or (2) ~~or~~, 948.025, or 948.10, the court shall  
6           impose a deoxyribonucleic acid analysis surcharge of \$250.

7           **SECTION 2.** 973.047 (1f) of the statutes is amended to read:

8           973.047 (1f) If a court imposes a sentence or places a person on probation for  
9           a felony conviction or for a conviction for a violation of s. 940.225 (3m), 944.20, or  
10          948.10, the court shall require the person to provide a biological specimen to the state  
11          crime laboratories for deoxyribonucleic acid analysis.

12          **SECTION 3. Initial applicability.**

1 (1) The treatment of section 973.047 (1f) of the statutes first applies to  
2 convictions entered and to persons who are serving the confinement portion of any  
3 sentence or who are on parole, probation, or extended supervision on the effective  
4 date of this subsection.

5 (2) The treatment of section 973.046 (1r) of the statutes first applies to persons  
6 who are sentenced or placed on probation on the effective date of this subsection.

7 **SECTION 4. Effective date.**

8 (1) This act takes effect on the first day of the 2nd month beginning after  
9 publication.
