



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2005 SENATE BILL 1**

June 16, 2005 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON CAMPAIGN FINANCE REFORM AND ETHICS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 7, line 14: after “may” insert “, with the approval of the board,”.

3 **2.** Page 7, line 16: delete “The” and substitute “Subject to the procedures under
4 this subdivision, the”.

5 **3.** Page 7, line 19: after “board.” insert “Prior to employing special counsel, the
6 division shall submit a written request for this purpose to the board. If the board does
7 not disapprove the request within 7 days of receiving the request, the division may
8 proceed to employ special counsel as provided in this paragraph.”.

9 **4.** Page 11, line 18: delete “The division” and substitute “Subject to the
10 procedures under this subsection, the division”.

11 **5.** Page 11, line 21: after “investigation.” insert “Prior to issuing a subpoena
12 or obtaining a search warrant, the division shall submit a written request for this
13 purpose to the board. If the board does not disapprove the request within 7 days of

1 receiving the request, the division may issue the subpoena or obtain the search
2 warrant.”.

3 **6.** Page 30, line 14: after that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 61m.** 17.07 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 17.07 (6) Other state officers serving in an office that is filled by appointment
6 of any officer or body without the concurrence of the governor, by the officer or body
7 having the authority to make appointments to that office, at pleasure, except that
8 officers appointed according to merit and fitness under and subject to ch. 230 or
9 officers whose removal is governed by ch. 230 may be removed only in conformity
10 with that chapter, and except that the administrator of the enforcement division in
11 the government accountability board may be removed from office only by the
12 executive director of the board, for cause.”.
