



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2005 SENATE BILL 394**

April 7, 2006 - Offered by Representative BENEDICT.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 448.03 (1) (a); and **to create** 448.015 (1g) of the statutes;  
2 **relating to:** electromyography.

---

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill provides that only a physician licensed in this state may perform a needle electromyography. A “needle electromyography” is the recording for diagnostic purposes of electrical activity generated by a muscle using a needle electrode.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3 **SECTION 1.** 448.015 (1g) of the statutes is created to read:

4 448.015 (1g) “Needle electromyography” means the recording for diagnostic  
5 purposes of electrical activity generated by a muscle using a needle electrode.

6 **SECTION 2.** 448.03 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 448.03 (1) LICENSE REQUIRED TO PRACTICE. (a) No person may practice medicine  
8 and surgery, or perform a needle electromyography, or attempt to do so or make a

1 representation as authorized to do so, without a license to practice medicine and  
2 surgery granted by the board.
