**SENATE AMENDMENT 6,
TO 2005 SENATE BILL 46**

March 16, 2005 – Offered by Senator **RISSER**.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 71, line 22: delete “designated by individuals for deposit in” and
3 substitute “transferred to”.

4 **2.** Page 82, line 16: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
5 with page 83, line 12, and substitute:

6 “71.10 **(3)** CAMPAIGN. (a) Every individual filing an income tax return who has
7 a tax liability or is entitled to a tax refund may indicate on the return that the
8 individual does not wish \$5 to be transferred to the Wisconsin election campaign
9 fund. If the individuals filing a joint return have a tax liability or are entitled to a
10 tax refund, each individual may indicate on the return that the individual does not
11 wish \$5 to be transferred to the Wisconsin election campaign fund. The amounts
12 transferred under this paragraph shall be placed in the general account for the use
13 of all eligible candidates for state office unless the individual specifies that his or her

1 transferred amount shall be placed in the account of an eligible political party whose
2 name is certified to the secretary of revenue under s. 11.50 (14).

3 (b) The secretary of revenue shall provide a place for indications and
4 specifications under par. (a) on the face of the individual income tax return and shall
5 provide next to that place a statement that an indication will not affect the amount
6 of the individual's tax liability or refund. No later than the 15th day of each month,
7 the secretary of revenue shall certify to the elections board, the department of
8 administration, and the state treasurer the total number of individuals filing income
9 tax returns who had a tax liability or were entitled to a refund during the preceding
10 month, less the number of individuals making an indication under par. (a),
11 multiplied by \$5. If any individual attempts to place any condition or restriction
12 upon an indication under par. (a), other than a specification under par. (a), that
13 individual is deemed not to have made an indication.”.
