632.89 (5m) Special applicability. Notwithstanding s. 600.01 (1) (b) 3., this section applies to any group health benefit plan that would otherwise be exempt under s. 600.01 (1) (b) 3. if at least 150 of the certificate holders or insureds are residents of this state.".
