**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 841**

April 13, 2010 – Offered by Representative MOLEPSKE JR..

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 7: after “routes,” insert “snowmobile safety instruction for
persons under 16 years of age,”.

3 **2.** Page 22, line 12: after that line insert:

4 “SECTION 59m. 350.055 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 350.055 (1) The department shall establish a program of instruction on
6 snowmobile laws, including the intoxicated snowmobiling law, regulations, safety
7 and related subjects. The program shall be conducted by instructors certified by the
8 department. The department may procure liability insurance coverage for certified
9 instructors for work within the scope of their duties under this section. ~~For each~~
10 ~~person who is under the age of 16 years, the program shall include 6 hours of~~
11 ~~classroom instruction, and the instructor may provide to the person up to 2~~
12 ~~additional hours of instruction on a snowmobile as to how it is actually operated.~~

1 Each person satisfactorily completing this program shall receive a snowmobile
2 safety certificate from the department. The department shall establish by rule an
3 instruction fee for this program. An instructor conducting a program of instruction
4 under this section shall collect the instruction fee from each person who receives
5 instruction. The department may determine the portion of this fee, which may not
6 exceed 50%, that the instructor may retain to defray expenses incurred by the
7 instructor in conducting the program. The instructor shall remit the remainder of
8 the fee or, if nothing is retained, the entire fee to the department. The department
9 shall issue a duplicate certificate of accomplishment to a person who is entitled to a
10 duplicate certificate of accomplishment and who pays a fee of \$2.75.”
