**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2009 SENATE BILL 407**

March 17, 2010 – Offered by JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 6, line 2: after that line insert:

3 “SECTION 10h. 39.41 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 39.41 (2) (b) For each year that a scholar who receives a scholarship under par.
5 (a) is enrolled full time, maintains at least a 3.000 grade point average, or the
6 equivalent as determined by the institution or district school, and makes satisfactory
7 progress toward an associate degree, a bachelor’s degree, or a vocational diploma, the
8 student shall be exempt from all tuition and fees, including segregated fees, in the
9 subsequent year or, if the scholar does not enroll in a participating institution of
10 higher education in the subsequent year, in the 2nd year following the year in which
11 the scholar received the scholarship, except that the maximum scholarship for a
12 scholar who receives an original scholarship for the 1996–97 academic year or for any
13 academic year thereafter may not exceed \$2,250 per academic year. No scholar is

1 eligible for an exemption for more than 4 years in the University of Wisconsin System
2 or more than 3 years at a district school.

3 **SECTION 10k.** 39.41 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 39.41 **(3)** (b) For each year that a scholar who receives a scholarship under par.
5 (a) is enrolled full time, maintains at least a 3.000 grade point average, or the
6 equivalent as determined by the private institution, and makes satisfactory progress
7 toward a bachelor's degree, the student is eligible for a higher education scholarship
8 as determined under par. (a) in the subsequent year or, if the scholar does not enroll
9 in a participating institution of higher education in the subsequent year, in the 2nd
10 year following the year in which the scholar received the scholarship. No scholar is
11 eligible for a higher education scholarship for more than 4 years at a private
12 institution of higher education.

13 **SECTION 10p.** 39.41 (5) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

14 39.41 **(5)** (b) Each designated scholar who is eligible for ~~a~~ an original higher
15 education scholarship under sub. (2) (a) or (3) (a) shall notify the board as soon as
16 practicable of the institution of higher education he or she will be attending in the
17 next academic year. Each designated scholar who is eligible for a subsequent higher
18 education scholarship under sub. (2) (a) or (3) (a) shall notify the board as soon as
19 practicable whether he or she will be enrolling in a participating institution of higher
20 education in the academic year immediately following the academic year in which
21 he or she received an original or subsequent scholarship under sub. (2) (a) or (3) (a),
22 or in the 2nd academic year, following that academic year and of the institution of
23 higher education in which he or she will be enrolling.”.
