23	(1) CIRCUIT COURT BRANCHES, 2012. The initial election for circuit judge for branch
24	2 of the circuit court for Calumet County, branch 2 of the circuit court for Adams

County, branch 2 of the circuit court for Waushara County, branch 4 of the circuit
court for Wood county, branch 2 of the circuit court for Jackson County, branch 2 of
the circuit court for Langlade County, branch 6 of the circuit court for Marathon
County, branch 2 of the circuit court for Vilas county, branch 3 of the circuit court for
Polk County, and branch 2 of the circuit court for Sawyer County shall be at the
spring election of 2012 for terms commencing August 1, 2012, and ending July 31,
2018.

8 (2) CIRCUIT JUDGE POSITIONS. The authorized FTE positions for the circuit courts 9 are increased by 10.0 FTE positions on August 1, 2012, to be funded from the 10 appropriation under section 20.625 (1) (a) of the statutes, to provide additional 11 circuit court judges for the circuit court branches created by this act.".
