Upon application and payment of the fee specified in s. 440.05 (6), the affiliated credentialing board may grant a temporary dietitian certificate license to an individual who satisfies the requirements under s. 448.78 (1) to (4) and has submitted an application to take the next available examination under s. 448.84. A temporary-certificate license granted under this section is valid for a period designated by the affiliated credentialing board, not to exceed 9 12 months, and may be renewed once by the affiliated credentialing board.

Section 229w. 448.82 of the statutes is amended to read:

448.82 Reciprocal certificate license. Upon application and payment of the fee specified in s. 440.05 (2), the affiliated credentialing board shall grant a dietitian certificate license to an individual who holds a similar certificate or license in another state or territory of the United States if the affiliated credentialing board determines that the requirements for receiving the certificate or license in the other state or territory are substantially equivalent to the requirements under s. 448.78.

SECTION 229x. 448.86 (title) and (1) of the statutes are amended to read:

448.86 (title) Issuance of eertificate <u>license</u>; expiration and renewal.

(1) The department shall issue a <u>certificate license</u> to each individual who is <u>certified</u> licensed under this subchapter.

Section 229y. 448.86 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

448.86 (2) The renewal dates for <u>certificates licenses</u> granted under this subchapter, other than temporary <u>certificates</u> licenses granted under s. 448.80, are

SECTION 229z. 448.87 (2) (intro.) and (a) of the statutes are amended to read:

448.87 **(2)** (intro.) Subject to the rules promulgated under s. 440.03 (1), the affiliated credentialing board may reprimand a certified <u>licensed</u> dietitian or deny, limit, suspend, or revoke a certificate <u>licensed</u> granted under this subchapter if it finds that the applicant or certified <u>licensed</u> dietitian has done any of the following:

- (a) Made a material misstatement in an application for a <u>certificate license</u> or for renewal of a <u>certificate license</u>."

Notwithstanding section 448.78 of the statutes, as affected by this act, on the effective date of this subsection, a person who, immediately prior to the effective date of this subsection, held a valid certificate as a dietitian granted by the dietitians affiliated credentialing board, is considered to be a licensed dietitian under section 448.70 (5), as affected by this act, and, before July 1, 2013, the dietitians affiliated credentialing board shall issue a license to the person under sections 448.78 and 448.86 of the statutes, as affected by this act."
