ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 5, TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 572

March 2, 2012 - Offered by Representative Krusick.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

- **1.** Page 1, line 7: after "Corporation" insert "and terms for members of the board of the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation.".
 - **2.** Page 4, line 13: after that line insert:
- **"Section 4m.** 238.02 (1) of the statutes, as created by 2011 Wisconsin Act 7, is amended to read:

238.02 (1) There is created an authority, which is a public body corporate and politic, to be known as the "Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation." The members of the board shall consist of the governor, who shall serve as chairperson of the board, and 6 members nominated by the governor, and with the advice and consent of the senate appointed, to serve at the pleasure of the governor 3-year terms; 3 members appointed by the speaker of the assembly, consisting of one majority and one minority party representative to the assembly, appointed as are the

members of standing committees in the assembly, and one person employed in the private sector, to serve at the speaker's pleasure appointed for a 3-year term; and 3 members appointed by the senate majority leader, consisting of one majority and one minority party senator, appointed as are members of standing committees in the senate, and one person employed in the private sector, to serve at the majority leader's pleasure appointed for a 3-year term. The secretary of administration and the secretary of revenue shall also serve on the board as nonvoting members.".

3. Page 7, line 11: after that line insert:

"Section 16m. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) Initial terms of members of the Wisconsin Economic Development Board under section 238.02 (1) of the statutes, as affected by this act, 2 of the initial members appointed by the governor shall be appointed for a term expiring on May 1, 2013, 2 of the initial members appointed by the governor shall be appointed for a term expiring on May 1, 2014, 2 of the initial members appointed by the governor shall be appointed by the governor shall be appointed for a term expiring on May 1, 2014, 2 of the initial members appointed by the governor shall be appointed for a term expiring on May 1, 2015, the initial private sector member appointed by the speaker of the assembly shall be appointed for a term expiring on May 1, 2014, and the initial private sector member appointed by the majority leader of the senate shall be appointed for a term expiring on May 1, 2015.".
