ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO 2011 SENATE BILL 228

November 1, 2011 – Offered by Representatives Molepske Jr, Danou, Hulsey, Milroy and Clark.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 3, line 24: after " <u>unloaded</u> " insert " <u>and encased</u> ".
3	2. Page 4, line 1: delete lines 1 and 2 and substitute:
4	" <u>2. The</u> bow or crossbow is unstrung or is enclosed in a carrying case <u>and does</u>
5	not have an arrow nocked.".
6	3. Page 4, line 4: delete that line and substitute:
7	"167.31 (2) (b) 3. The crossbow is enclosed in a carrying case and is not cocked.".
8	4. Page 4, line 18: after that line insert:
9	"SECTION 15g. 167.31 (4) (bu) of the statutes is created to read:
10	167.31 (4) (bu) The requirement under sub. (2) (b) that a firearm, crossbow, or
11	bow be encased does not apply if the firearm, crossbow, or bow is being transported
12	in a vehicle that is traveling between hunting sites and the individual who is
13	transporting the firearm, crossbow, or bow is actively involved in hunting.

2011 – 2012 Legislature – 2 –

SECTION 15m. 167.31 (4) (bv) of the statutes is created to read:

167.31 (4) (bv) The requirement under sub. (2) (b) that a firearm, crossbow, or
bow be encased does not apply if the firearm, crossbow, or bow is being transported
in a vehicle from a store or other location where the firearm, crossbow, or bow has just
been purchased to the residence of the purchaser and if the seller of the firearm,
crossbow, or bow fails to provide a case or other packaging that results in no part of
the firearm, crossbow, or bow being exposed.".
