ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 493

November 14, 2013 - Offered by Representatives Mason, Riemer, C. Taylor and Hulsey.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

- **1.** Page 1, line 2: delete the material beginning with "exemption" and ending with "from" on line 3.
 - **2.** Page 2, line 3: after that line insert:
- **"Section 1m.** 5.02 (6m) (h) of the statutes is created to read:
 - 5.02 (6m) (h) If an individual is a student at a university, college, or technical college in this state and is not able to present any of the documents specified in pars.

 (a) to (f), an affidavit in the form prescribed by the board specifying the individual's name and address, affirming the individual's identity, and stating that this is the address of the individual's residence.".
- **3.** Page 5, line 10: after that line insert:
- 12 "Section 6g. 7.51 (5) (a) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:

7.51 (5) (a) 4. The inspectors shall immediately deliver all ballots, statements, tally sheets, lists, and envelopes, and affidavits to the municipal clerk.

Section 6r. 7.51 (5) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

7.51 (5) (b) The municipal clerk shall deliver all ballots, statements, tally sheets, lists, and envelopes relating to a school district election to the school district clerk, excluding any absentee ballots that are received after the closing hour on election night and any provisional ballots, by 4 p.m. on the day following each such election and shall deliver to the school district clerk any amended statements, tally sheets, and lists for additional provisional and absentee ballots canvassed under s. 6.97 (4) or 7.515 (6) (b) no later than 4 p.m. on the Monday after the election. The municipal clerk shall deliver to the county clerk the ballots, statements, tally sheets, lists, and envelopes for his or her municipality relating to any county, technical college district, state, or national election no later than 4 p.m. on the day following each such election or, in municipalities where absentee ballots are canvassed under s. 7.52, by 4 p.m. on the 2nd day following each such election, and shall deliver to the county clerk any additional provisional and absentee ballots canvassed under s. 6.97 (4) or 7.515 (6) (b) together with amended statements, tally sheets, lists, and envelopes no later than 4 p.m. on the Monday after the election. The person delivering the returns shall be paid out of the municipal treasury. Each clerk shall retain ballots, statements, tally sheets, or envelopes, and affidavits received by the clerk until destruction is authorized under s. 7.23 (1).".

- **4.** Page 5, line 16: after "sections" insert "5.02 (6m) (h),".
- **5.** Page 5, line 17: after "(cm)" insert "and (5) (a) 4. and (b)".
