



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 4,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 782**

March 5, 2014 – Offered by Representatives SINICKI and KESSLER.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2           **1.** Page 5, line 15: after that line insert:

3           “(f) 1. Notwithstanding par. (a), a town, village, or city may enact and enforce  
4           an ordinance establishing minimum standards for constructing, altering, or adding  
5           to public buildings or buildings that are places of employment that are stricter than  
6           the applicable rules under sub. (15) (j) if the town, village, or city submits a petition  
7           to the building code council for authorization to enact and enforce such an ordinance  
8           and the building code council approves the petition.

9           2. The building code council may approve a petition under subd. 1. only if the  
10          council finds that the ordinance is necessary to address a concern that is specific to  
11          that town, village, or city and that relates to health, safety, welfare, or economic  
12          development.”.
