



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 145**

May 7, 2013 – Offered by Representatives KESSLER, OHNSTAD, GOYKE, PASCH and JOHNSON.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 19: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 3m.** 346.60 (3m) (a) of the statutes, as affected by 2013 Wisconsin Act
4 (this act), is amended to read:

5 346.60 (**3m**) (a) If an operator of a vehicle violates s. 346.57 (2), (3), (4) (d) to
6 (h), or (5) where persons engaged in work in a highway maintenance or construction
7 area or in a utility work area are at risk from traffic or where sanitation workers are
8 at risk from traffic, each vehicle used by the sanitation workers is displaying
9 flashing, oscillating, or rotating warning lights, and the operator knows or should
10 know that sanitation workers are present, any applicable minimum and maximum
11 forfeiture specified in sub. (2) or (3) for the violation shall be doubled.”

12 **2.** Page 3, line 6: after that line insert:

1 “**SECTION 4m.** 346.65 (5m) of the statutes, as affected by 2013 Wisconsin Act
2 (this act), is amended to read:

3 346.65 **(5m)** If an operator of a vehicle violates s. 346.62 (2) to (4) where persons
4 engaged in work in a highway maintenance or construction area or in a utility work
5 area are at risk from traffic or where sanitation workers are at risk from traffic, each
6 vehicle used by the sanitation workers is displaying flashing, oscillating, or rotating
7 warning lights, and the operator knows or should know that sanitation workers are
8 present, any applicable minimum and maximum forfeiture or fine specified in sub.
9 (1), (3), (4m), or (5) for the violation shall be doubled.”.

10 **3.** Page 3, line 15: after that line insert:

11 “**SECTION 5m.** 349.06 (3) of the statutes, as affected by 2013 Wisconsin Act
12 (this act), is amended to read:

13 349.06 **(3)** If an operator of a vehicle violates a local ordinance in strict
14 conformity with s. 346.04 (1) or (2), 346.18 (6), 346.27, 346.37, 346.39, 346.46 (1),
15 346.57 (2), (3), (4) (d) to (h), or (5), or 346.62 (2) where persons engaged in work in
16 a highway maintenance or construction area or in a utility work area are at risk from
17 traffic or violates a local ordinance in strict conformity with s. 346.57 (2), (3), (4) (d)
18 to (h), or (5) or 346.62 (2) where sanitation workers are at risk from traffic, each
19 vehicle used by the sanitation workers is displaying flashing, oscillating, or rotating
20 warning lights, and the operator knows or should know that sanitation workers are
21 present, any applicable minimum and maximum forfeiture for the violation shall be
22 doubled.”.

23 **4.** Page 3, line 18: after that line insert:

24 “**SECTION 7m. Effective date.**
