**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 124**

May 18, 2015 - Offered by Representative ZAMARRIPA.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 9.01 (1) (ag) 1., 9.01 (1) (ag) 1m., 9.01 (1) (ag) 2. and 9.01 (1)
2 (ag) 3m.; and *to create* 9.01 (1) (ag) 1d. of the statutes; **relating to:** fees for
3 election recounts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 9.01 (1) (ag) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

5 9.01 (1) (ag) 1. If the difference between the votes cast for the leading candidate
6 and those cast for the petitioner or the difference between the affirmative and
7 negative votes cast upon any referendum question is equal to or less than 10 if 1,000
8 or less votes are cast or not more than ~~0.5%~~ 0.25 percent of the total votes cast for the
9 office or on the question if more than 1,000 votes are cast following canvassing of all
10 valid provisional and absentee ballots, the petitioner is not required to pay a fee.

11 **SECTION 2.** 9.01 (1) (ag) 1d. of the statutes is created to read:

1 9.01 (1) (ag) 1d. If the difference between the votes cast for the leading
2 candidate and those cast for the petitioner or the difference between the affirmative
3 and negative votes cast upon any referendum question is more than 0.25 percent but
4 not more than 0.5 percent if more than 1,000 votes are cast following canvassing of
5 all valid provisional and absentee ballots, the petitioner shall pay a fee of \$25 for each
6 ward for which the petition requests a ballot recount, or \$25 for each municipality
7 for which the petition requests a recount where no wards exist.

8 **SECTION 3.** 9.01 (1) (ag) 1m. of the statutes is amended to read:

9 9.01 (1) (ag) 1m. If the difference between the votes cast for the leading
10 candidate and those cast for the petitioner or the difference between the affirmative
11 and negative votes cast upon any referendum question is at least more than 10 if
12 1,000 or less votes are cast, but not more than 25, or is more than ~~0.5%~~ 0.5 percent
13 but not more than ~~2%~~ 1 percent if more than 1,000 votes are cast following canvassing
14 of all valid provisional and absentee ballots, the petitioner shall pay a fee of \$5 \$50
15 for each ward for which the petition requests a ballot recount, or \$5 \$50 for each
16 municipality for which the petition requests a recount where no wards exist.

17 **SECTION 4.** 9.01 (1) (ag) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

18 9.01 (1) (ag) 2. If the difference between the votes cast for the leading candidate
19 and those cast for the petitioner or the difference between the affirmative and
20 negative votes cast upon any referendum question is more than 25 if 1,000 or less
21 votes are cast or more than ~~2%~~ 1 percent if more than 1,000 votes are cast following
22 canvassing of all valid provisional and absentee ballots, the petitioner shall pay a fee
23 equal to the actual cost of performing the recount in each ward for which the petition
24 requests a recount, or in each municipality for which the petition request requests
25 a recount where no wards exist.
