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SENATE AMENDMENT 2, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 373

January 20, 2016 – Offered by Senators C. Larson, Ringhand, Bewley, Harris Dodd, Vinehout, Miller, Erpenbach, Risser, Shilling, Lassa and Hansen.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 2, line 5: before "and making" insert ", providing a criminal penalty,".
3	2. Page 35, line 2: after that line insert:
4	"SECTION 91s. 946.12 (6) of the statutes is created to read:
5	946.12 (6) In the capacity of a legislator or the governor, administers or
6	threatens to administer an action in retaliation against a public employee for an
7	action taken in the employee's official capacity, for an exercise of the employee's
8	rights under the first amendment to the U.S. Constitution or under article I, section
9	3, of the Wisconsin Constitution, or for reporting of fraud, waste, or mismanagement
LO	in government if the effect of the legislator's or governor's action would be any of the
11	following:

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(a) Dismissal, demotion, transfer, removal of any duty assigned to the public
 employee's position, refusal to restore, suspension, reprimand, verbal or physical
 harassment, or reduction in base pay.

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4 (b) Denial of education or training if the education or training may reasonably
5 be expected to lead to an appointment, promotion, performance evaluation, or other
6 personnel action.

7 (c) Reassignment.

8 (d) Failure to increase base pay, except with respect to the determination of a
9 discretionary performance award.".
