**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 52**

February 15, 2016 - Offered by Representative GOYKE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 5, line 7: delete lines 7 to 9 and substitute:

3 “11. A circuit court judge or court of appeals judge.

4 12. A representative of the office of the governor, who shall serve as a nonvoting
5 member of the council.”.

6 **2.** Page 5, line 19: delete that line and substitute:

7 “18. Any additional members whom the governor may appoint, who may
8 include representatives of the public at large.”.

9 **3.** Page 5, line 22: delete “to 7.” and substitute “and 2. and other members
10 designated by the cochairpersons”.

11 **4.** Page 5, line 23: after that line insert:

1 “(cg) The cochairpersons may create subcommittees as they deem necessary
2 and engage other stakeholders and members of the public to participate in
3 subcommittee activities.

4 (cm) Each executive agency with membership on the criminal justice
5 coordinating council shall, upon request of the council, designate agency staff to
6 provide assistance to the council.”.

7 **5.** Page 6, line 20: delete “the legislature, the” and substitute “the legislature,
8 and”.

9 **6.** Page 6, line 21: delete that line.

10 **7.** Page 6, line 22: delete “workforce development” and substitute “relevant
11 state agencies”.

12 **8.** Page 7, line 3: delete “the department”.

13 **9.** Page 7, line 4: delete that line.

14 **10.** Page 7, line 5: delete “development” and substitute “and relevant state
15 agencies”.

16 **11.** Page 7, line 12: delete “Facilitate the development of county” and
17 substitute “Encourage and facilitate the development of effective county”.

18 **12.** Page 7, line 13: delete “oversight committees” and substitute
19 “coordinating councils to foster innovations based on local criminal justice
20 environments”.

21 **13.** Page 7, line 14: delete lines 14 to 17 and substitute:

22 “(5) Through the cooperation and collaboration of agencies enumerated in sub.
23 (13), the council shall develop, analyze, and make recommendations to the governor,

1 the legislature, and relevant state agencies to implement a reporting system to track
2 key criminal justice indicators, trends, and outcomes related to policies designed to
3 do the following:

4 (a) Reduce prison, jail, and detention populations.

5 (b) Improve rehabilitative efforts.

6 (c) Reduce recidivism.

7 (d) Enhance reentry strategies for offenders released from prison or jail, acting
8 consistent with public safety and holding offenders accountable.”.

9 **14.** Page 7, line 21: delete that line and substitute:

10 “(7) Promote the evaluation of new and current criminal justice policies after
11 implementation. Considerations include impact of current law on public safety,
12 policies’ or programs’ effect on crime reduction, recidivism, prison and jail
13 populations, and overall criminal justice costs.”.

14 **15.** Page 7, line 22: delete “legislature, the” and substitute “legislature, and”.

15 **16.** Page 7, line 23: delete that line.

16 **17.** Page 7, line 24: delete “workforce development” and substitute “relevant
17 state agencies”.

18 **18.** Page 8, line 3: delete lines 3 and 4 and substitute:

19 “(9) Study whether disparities based on race, gender, socioeconomic status, or
20 other factors exist in various types of treatment courts and the traditional criminal
21 justice system and”.

22 **19.** Page 8, line 10: delete “Annually” and substitute “Periodically”.

23 **20.** Page 8, line 15: delete “, on a monthly basis,”.

1 **21.** Page 8, line 19: before “average” insert “aggregate”.

2 **22.** Page 8, line 20: before “number” insert “aggregate”.

3 **23.** Page 9, line 3: after that line insert:

4 “(13) Receive assistance from executive branch agencies. All executive branch
5 agencies shall aid the criminal justice coordinating council to the greatest extent
6 possible. At the request of the council, the department of corrections, the parole
7 commission, the department of health services, the department of children and
8 families, the department of workforce development, the department of justice, the
9 department of transportation, the state prosecutor’s office, and the department of
10 administration shall provide the council with information and data needed by the
11 council to perform its duties under this section.

12 (14) Cooperate and collaborate with the judicial branch. At the request of the
13 council, the office of the director of state courts shall provide, to the extent the
14 director of state courts determines practicable, information and data that is needed
15 by the council to perform its duties under this section.

16 (15) Engage in other activities consistent with the criminal justice
17 coordinating council.”.

18 **24.** Page 9, line 7: delete that line and substitute:

19 “SECTION 8m. 165.95 (1) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 165.95 (1) (ar) 1.”.

20 **25.** Page 9, line 15: delete “who has been charged with” and substitute “to
21 whom one of the following applies:”.

22 **26.** Page 9, line 16: delete lines 16 to 20.

23 **27.** Page 10, line 1: delete lines 1 to 4.
