**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 751**

February 3, 2016 - Offered by Representative Vos.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 8: after “program” insert “and the open enrollment transfer
3 amount for children with disabilities”.

4 **2.** Page 7, line 15: after that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 19b.** 118.51 (17) (a) of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act
6 55, is renumbered 118.51 (17) (a) (intro.) and amended to read:

7 118.51 (17) (a) (intro.) In the 2015-16 school year Beginning in the 2016-17
8 school year and annually thereafter, for a child with a disability who satisfies all of
9 the following, the resident school board shall pay to the nonresident school board, for
10 each that child who is attending public school in the nonresident school district under
11 this section and is receiving special education or related services under subch. V of
12 ch. 115, with a disability tuition calculated using the daily tuition rate under s.

1 121.83 for such children enrolled in the nonresident school district, or, subject to par.
2 (am), an amount agreed to by the school boards of the 2 school districts.;

3 **SECTION 19f.** 118.51 (17) (a) 1. to 4. of the statutes are created to read:

4 118.51 (17) (a) 1. The child attended a public school in a nonresident school
5 district under this section in the 2015-16 school year.

6 2. The child received special education or related services under subch. V of ch.
7 115 in the public school described under subd. 1.

8 3. The child is attending the public school described under subd. 1. under this
9 section in the current school year.

10 4. The child is receiving special education or related services under subch. V
11 of ch. 115 in the current school year.

12 **SECTION 19k.** 118.51 (17) (am) of the statutes is created to read:

13 118.51 (17) (am) Following the review and revision under s. 115.787 (4) of the
14 individualized education program of a child with a disability described in par. (a), the
15 school boards of the resident school district and the nonresident school district may
16 agree to modify the amount the resident school board will pay to the nonresident
17 school board for that child with a disability.

18 **SECTION 19p.** 118.51 (17) (b) 1. a. of the statutes, as created by 2015 Wisconsin
19 Act 55, is amended to read:

20 118.51 (17) (b) 1. a. For each school district, the number of nonresident pupils
21 attending public school in the school district under this section, other than
22 nonresident pupils described in par. (a), who are receiving special education or
23 related services under subch. V of ch. 115.

24 **SECTION 19s.** 118.51 (17) (b) 1. b. of the statutes, as created by 2015 Wisconsin
