**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 787**

January 29, 2016 - Offered by Representative ROHRKASTE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 1: before “funding” insert “participation in and”.

3 **2.** Page 1, line 3: before that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 1w.** 46.87 (5) (a) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

5 46.87 (5) (a) 3. The household meets financial eligibility requirements specified
6 by the department by rule in sub. (5m), and persons in the household are ineligible
7 for the family care benefit under s. 46.286 in a county in which a care management
8 organization under s. 46.284 operates.

9 **SECTION 1wc.** 46.87 (5) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 46.87 (5) (b) Provide or contract for the provision of services and goods or make
11 payments for services to a person with Alzheimer’s disease living in a residential
12 facility in the county who meets financial eligibility requirements specified by the
13 ~~department by rule~~ in sub. (5m) and is ineligible for the family care benefit under s.

1 46.286 in a county in which a care management organization under s. 46.284
2 operates.

3 **SECTION 1y.** 46.87 (5m) of the statutes is created to read:

4 46.87 **(5m)** A person is financially eligible for the program under this section
5 if the joint income of the person with Alzheimer's disease and that person's spouse,
6 if any, is \$48,000 per year or less, unless the department sets a higher limitation on
7 income eligibility by rule. In determining joint income for purposes of this
8 subsection, the administering agency shall subtract any expenses attributable to the
9 Alzheimer's-related needs of the person with Alzheimer's disease or of the person's
10 caregiver.".
